Meiji Group Joins a Global Initiative RE100
Achieving the Meiji Group Long-term Environmental Vision,
Meiji Green Engagement for 2050 by using renewable energy to contribute to
a healthy future, for people, and for the earth.

Meiji Holdings Co., Ltd. (President and Representative Director, CEO: Kazuo Kawamura) is pleased to announce that we joined a global initiative RE100 on September 16, 2021. RE100 is an initiative through which companies commit to using 100% renewable electricity for business operations. We received support for the enrollment process from the Japan Climate Leaders' Partnership (JCLP), a group of companies committed to achieving a sustainable, carbon-free society.



RE100 is a global initiative bringing together the world's most influential companies leading the transition to 100% renewable electricity. Led by international non-profit the Climate Group in partnership with CDP. As of August 24, 2021, RE100 has 323 member companies worldwide, including 59 companies in Japan.

In December 2020, the Meiji Group outlined Meiji Green Engagement for 2050, our long-term environment vision to address four core themes: climate change, water resources, resource recycling, and pollution prevention. As a part of our climate change initiatives, we outline the goal of becoming carbon neutral (net zero CO₂ and other greenhouse gas emissions) across our entire supply chain by 2050.

As of April 2021, Meiji Co., Ltd., our Group company, has already achieved RE100 compliance at its Aichi Plant by using 100% renewable energy for all its electricity needs. We will continue to aggressively adopt renewable energy towards our goal of achieving a sustainable society.
